

EXCURSIONS



Lastovo

travel time: 5-minute drive.

activities: history tour, walking and hiking.

The first excursion is a visit to the main village of Lastovo. It was constructed around the 14th century and named after the largest island of the 46 islands of the archipelago. Lastovo is seen as the heart of the island, the main gathering place where everyday necessities are bought and where all main events occur such as the annual 'Poklad' Carnival. The city council, post office, Rector's Palace and main parish church of Saint Cosmas and Damian can all be found here within walking distance of each other. The walk begins on the main street called the Pjevor, right in front of the shops closest to your accommodation. Here you will have an opportunity to buy any essentials you may need, after which you will continue to walk through the town for approximately 30 minutes. This is followed by a hike up to the hilltop Glavica on which stands an old fort from the French occupation of the island. From here, you can enjoy views of Lastovo, Zaklopatica Bay and the neighboring island Korčula. You can also see the north-eastern islands of Lastovo's archipelago including Saplun, an island you will be visiting in the coming days. The excursion will conclude at a local café for a well-deserved break.

things to remember: a bottle of water, hiking footwear and money or bank cards for the local store, ATM, or post office to exchange money if you require.



Mihajla Beach

travel time: 5 minutes via speedboat.

activities: Swimming, volleyball, and SUP-riding.

Mihajla Beach is located at the bottom of Lastovo and is known as the go-to swimming spot for the locals and tourists. Adjacent to the water is a cemented promenade with a sand volleyball court and the café-bar Mihajla which offers drinks, coffee, and ice-cream. For those willing, you can have a turn riding the SUP attached to the speed boat.

things to remember: beachwear, sunscreen, and money if you would like to go to the café-bar.



Skrivena Luka

travel time: 15-minute drive.

activities: lighthouse visit, swimming, and dinner.

Skrivena Luka, more commonly known among the locals as Portorus, is located on the south side of the island and is one of the largest and most beautiful bays that the island has to offer. Just as its name suggests, the port is hidden from sight from the open sea which provides boats ideal protection from gale-forced winds and rough seas. At the middle of the south side of Lastovo at the entrance of Skrivena Luka is the lighthouse named Struga built in 1839. and named after the cliff it resides on. The lighthouse is approximately 90 meters above sea level and the cliffside views of the open sea are breathtaking. This excursion is held on a free day where you will spend the whole afternoon in Skrivena Luka and finish with an organized dinner at the restaurant Porto Rosso.

reminders: this excursion takes up the entire afternoon so you will be returning to the accommodation only after dinner.



Pasadur

travel time: 15-minute drive.

Pasadur is a bay situated on the west-side of the island and carries over to the island of Prežba connected by a bridge just past the hotel.

Favorite location for boaters as the bay is protected from high winds and has a scenic promenade by the sea, enjoyed by tourists and locals alike.



Saplun

travel time: 20 minutes via speedboat.

Saplun is found on the island Mladine among the islands known as Lastovnjaci in the lower part of Lastovo's archipelago. Saplun is the only sandy beach on Lastovo and its beauty doesn't go unnoticed by its visitors who arrive on their own private boats or via organized excursions. The shore is covered in smooth stones which lead into the breathtakingly sandy-bedded ocean floor which is perfect for playing water sports or taking underwater photos. It is important to note that there are no facilities available on the island for visitors as the island is still in its natural untouched state.

things to remember: water, sneakers, beachwear, and beach gear (towel, snorkels, sunscreen etc.).



Hum

Hum is a lookout located on the highest point on Lastovo 417 meters above sea level. This excursion begins in the late afternoon when you will be led on foot to the top so to arrive at sunset. The hike takes approximately 90 minutes, and you are driven back down by car.

things to remember: water, a long-sleeved top and hiking footwear.



Winery

This excursion is organized in the afternoon or evening and is in Lastovo's main village. It is a 5-minute drive from your accommodation gives you the opportunity to try all the traditional wines Lastovo has to offer made from grapes grown on Lastovo and which are typical of the region of Dalmatia.
